Autumn update

The clocks have gone back, the leaves are falling ... and the weather keeps changing! But we have some good news ...

Term dates

We're back on Zoom from 8.15pm on **Thursday 5 November** to **10 December** (slightly later time).

Face-to-face rehearsals

After a successful trial F2F session last week, we are pleased to offer small group rehearsals – operating under carefully managed safety protocols.

The hall has a high ceiling and good ventilation, so we are confident that the risks are minimal. Numbers are limited to 20 and the committee will organise a rota and let people know which night(s) they can attend.

However, you need to make your own decision about whether you feel comfortable attending rehearsals in person. To help you decide, our safety measures and the way the sessions will be run are:

- Sessions will start at 7.15 and finish at 8.00pm
- Please do not arrive before 7.10pm so that we can limit the contact choir members have prior to the rehearsal
- When you arrive at the hall, please wear face coverings and queue up outside the hall, ensuring that you are standing 2m apart from the person in front of you
- We will put all the chairs out in the hall prior to your arrival spaced out at 2m intervals
- We will sanitise all chairs prior to your arrival
- We will allow one person into the hall at a time, taking the temperature of each person in turn
- After your temperature check, please sanitise your hands using the hand sanitiser provided
- Then find a seat in your section, starting from the back if possible
- Once seated, please keep your face covering on until we start to sing. Then please use a face shield instead of the face covering whilst singing
- At the end of the rehearsal, please put your face covering back on and stay seated
- We will ask the front row to leave the hall first, then the 2nd row etc until everyone has left the hall (with only be 20 people this won't take long)



- We will sanitise the chairs and put them back on their trollies
- Ann will not be asking us to sing loudly during rehearsals!

The slightly later time for Zoom sessions at 8.15 will allow Ann and Christine to get home in time!
